WHO IS IT FOR?

Asbestos Awareness is a half day course for operational, supervisory and managerial staff who may be handling or coming into contact with asbestos, and that have responsibility for asbestos related activities. It focuses on types and occurrence of asbestos products, handling, potential risks and how to health and safety measures, legislation and compliance and dealing with incidents such as spillages.



Asbestos Awareness Training is required by law and is targeted at people who may come into contact with asbestos products such as plumbers, builders, demolition contractors, and those involved in wastes management.



COURSE STRUCTURE

Basic course content: can be adapted to client's wishes.

Introductions and ice breaker (to discover candidates' knowledge)

Basic legislation relating to asbestos

Types of asbestos

Examples of asbestos use (interactive session)

Risks from asbestos

Precautions and protection

A video or videos relating to asbestos will be shown to break up the sessions.

The course is interactive and candidates are encouraged to participate and share experiences. A short test is completed at the end.
